

Disposal Notices

If you ever dispose of your Neato Vacuum, follow these steps:

- Make sure your Neato robot vacuum is not attached to any power source.
- Completely discharged.
- Unscrew the battery doors, and unplug and remove the batteries.
- Take the robot vacuum to the nearest waste management electronics recycling center.
- Take the batteries to a battery-recycling program at your school, place of work, or nearest waste management battery recycling center.
- The batteries must under no circumstances come into contact with metal.



The symbol is relevant to the WEEE directive 2012/19/EU as well as the battery directive 2006/66/EU.

Batteries

If the batteries leak due to overheating or physical abuse, place them in a plastic bag and dispose of them in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local regulations. Following battery removal procedure above. The battery compartments in the Neato Vacuum should be wiped with a damp cloth and allowed to dry before installing new batteries.
